## Santa Cecilia Project - US\$48 million JV with Goldfields MULTIPLE DISCOVERIES MADE GOLD-COPPER

- Immediately adjacent to Newmont/Barrick's Norte Abierto project (4th largest undeveloped gold project, globally\*), hosting 1.29 Bt @ 0.54 g/t Au and 1.17 Bt @ 0.21% Cu in M&I resources, plus additional inferred1
- Phase I stepped out 700m and intercepted higher-grade gold mineralization Santa Cecilia (557 m of 0.38 g/t Au, 0.23% Cu & 56 ppm Mo<sup>3</sup>) than the 2012 historical intercept (925 m of 0.21 g/t Au, 0.27% Cu & 82 ppm Mo<sup>3</sup>) at Cerro del Medio
- Phase II drill program made a new discovery at the Pircas Norte target, intercepting 502 m of 0.36 g/t Au & 0.078% Cu2 and 120 m of 1.33 g/t Au & 0.096% Cu<sup>2</sup>
- Phase III drill program: A new copper gold porphyry discovery at the Gemelos Norte target, intercepting 652m of 0.42 g/t Au, 0.134% Cu & 61 ppm Mo<sup>2</sup>;

Mineralization extended at depth at the Pircas Norte target, intercepting 266m of 0.81 g/t Au & 0.097% Cu & 24 ppm Mo<sup>2</sup>

- Three distinct porphyry discoveries in less than 10 drill holes at Santa Cecilia
- Extensive drilling planned for 2025–2026 under joint venture, utilizing multiple drill rigs


